## THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

## Absence of a Board Director

Whenever possible each board director will give advance notice to the chair/president or superintendent of his/her inability to attend a board meeting. A majority of the board may excuse a board director's absence from a meeting if requested to do so.

The board may declare a board director's position vacant after four (4) consecutive unexcused absences from regular board meetings, if the absences were for reasons other than illness, active or training military duty, or those authorized by resolution of the board.

If a board director is on active duty or training status with the military, the board will grant an extended leave of absence to cover the period of service or training. The extended leave of absence may not have the effect of extending the board director's term. The board also has the authority to appoint a temporary successor to the absent board director's position. The temporary successor will serve until the board director returns or the end of the board director's term.
