THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Board Director Insurance

The district shall maintain sufficient insurance to protect the board and its individual directors against liability for personal or bodily injuries and property damage arising from their acts or omissions while performing, or in good faith purporting to perform, their official duties.

An individual board director may participate at his/her own cost in any of the personal liability, life, health, health care, accident, disability, salary protection, or other form of insurance made available to district staff if plan sponsors permit such participation.
