

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

Public Information

The Board encourages representatives of the news media to be present at Board meetings and to visit schools and other District facilities. The Board agenda and supporting materials are available online two days prior to the meeting. A hard copy is available in the Superintendent's Office.

In interviews with news media on school affairs only the President shall speak for the Board or may name a representative to speak for him/her. This usually will be the Secretary of the Board who is the superintendent.

The Community Relations Office shall coordinate all media requests. Staff members will work with their building/site administrator, who will then secure authorization from the Community Relations Office with regard to events, activities and programs for possible coverage in District communication materials and the media.

Annual District Report

The Annual District Report will include but not be limited to:

- A. A summary of the student performance towards state standards;
- B. Results of District-wide achievement testing; and
- C. Budget information, including student enrollment, classroom staff, support staff, administrative staff, and special levy expenditures.
