Vehicle Safety

The Board recognizes the importance of the safety of students, staff, and the public. Employees are responsible for the safe operation, in accordance with state and local laws and policies, of District vehicles or motorized equipment assigned to them. Because the operation of motor vehicles and motorized equipment create significant risks of injury to people and property, the Superintendent is directed to develop procedures to reasonably ensure that accidents involving District vehicles or motorized equipment are properly reported; operators of District vehicles or motorized equipment possess required licenses and permits; and, that persons with patterns of unsafe or illegal vehicle or motorized equipment operating practices are not employed in capacities that require the operation of District vehicles or motorized equipment.
