## ONSITE CLASSES AT FAIRVIEW MIDDLE SCHOOL

JULY 9 - AUGUST 2, 2018 8:00 AM - 12:00 NOON (MONDAY—THURSDAY)

### Summer Experience - Middle School P. E. - ON SITE

TUITION FOR THIS COURSE IS \$160.

THIS SATISFIES GRADE-SPECIFIC P.E. REQUIREMENT AND CAN BE TAKEN THE SUMMER BEFORE THE CLASS IS REQUIRED.

This class is limited to 25 students. This class does not earn high school credit.

**Registration for this class will close when all spots are filled or June 22, 2018.**

- MIDDLE SCHOOL P.E.** is open to students entering grades 6-8. See separate flyer for details about this option- dates (June 26—July 31) and site locations are different from other classes.

### Middle School Support Classes - ON SITE

THE FOLLOWING SUPPORT CLASSES ARE OPEN TO MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS WHO HAD DIFFICULTY WITH THE SKILLS AND CONCEPTS AND NEED ADDITIONAL SUPPORT PRIOR TO MOVING ON TO THE NEXT LEVEL.

*Middle School Support classes do not earn high school credit.*

- LITERACY LAB 7-8\*** is open to students entering grades 8 or 9
- PREPARING FOR MATH 1** is open to students entering grade 6
- PREPARING FOR MATH 2** is open to students entering grade 7
- MATH 2** is open to students entering grade 8
- MATH 3\*** is open to students entering grade 9

*\* Students entering grade 9, who have not yet passed at least one semester of Language Arts or Math 3 in grade 8, may take either of these courses to fulfill the promotion requirement.*

### Early Algebra I, Semester 1 High School Credit Recovery - ON SITE

**This course is open and highly recommended for students who failed BOTH semesters of Algebra I.**

**Students can then take the Algebra I, Semester 2 during Summer Academy.**

- ALGEBRA I (.5 Math credit) (Semester 1)** See separate flyer for details about this option- dates (June 25—July 3) and class is held at CKSD Teaching and Learning Center— 1400 NE McWilliams Rd, Bremerton, WA.

### High School Credit Recovery - ON SITE

THE FOLLOWING HIGH SCHOOL CLASSES ARE OPEN TO STUDENTS WHO HAVE FAILED A COURSE AND STILL NEED TO EARN THE SEMESTER-SPECIFIC COURSE CREDIT.

- ENGLISH 9 (.5 English credit) (Semester 1 or 2)**
- LITERATURE STUDY** is open to students who failed any high school English course (.5 English credit)
- ALGEBRA I (.5 Math credit) (Semester 1 or 2)**
- GEOMETRY (.5 Math credit) (Semester 1 or 2)**
- ALGEBRA II (.5 Math credit) (Semester 1 or 2)**

- **May be taken for Credit Recovery or Initial Credit**
- All orientations are at Fairview Middle School. Students registered by June 22 will receive an email and be able to access the courses starting June 27. Login information will also be available at orientation.
- Students registering after June 22 will be able to access courses within 4 business days of registering and will receive an email when they have access.
- Ask about I.E.P. and Section 504 accommodations before registering for online and Ind. Study classes.
